ARE YOU BETWEEN THE AGES OF 18-30 AND EXPERIENCING HOUSING INSECURITY?

The LA:RISE Youth Academy is a 250-hour work experience program focused on improving housing, education and workforce goals for unhoused or unstably housed young adults. Through the Youth Academy, every young adult participant will be linked to housing, education, employment, and social well-being services to move them to a future of self-sufficiency and economic mobility!

PROGRAM SERVICES:

- You will have a TEAM of dedicated staff assisting you each step of the way
- Become aware of occupations you can succeed in
- Job preparation: Learn how to answer interview questions
- · Short term certification training
- High school completion guidance
- Post-Secondary educational guidance
- Linkages to housing & other resources
- 250 hours of work training
- Earn up to \$4,000

ELIGIBILITY:

- 18-30 years of age
- City of Los Angeles resident (your dwelling must be located in the city of Los Angeles)
- Authorized to work in the U.S.
- Unemployed or working less than 20 hours per week
- Meet one of the housing criteria below:
 - Homeless OR
 - Temporarily housed OR
 - At-risk of Becoming Homeless (including couch surfing and TAY populations) OR
 - Fleeing/attempting to flee domestic violence

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE:

- Photo ID (government or school issued) or US
 Passport or US Permanent Residency Card AND
- ONE of: Social Security card or Employment Authorization (issued by the Dept. of Homeland Security)
