

# Los Angeles County - Expungement\* Legal Services

\* California law does not provide a full evisceration of criminal convictions. What is commonly called “expungement” is a dismissal of the conviction for most purposes. Consult a record cleaning attorney about the benefits and limitations of a dismissal or “expungement” for your goals and situation.
