You will have to wait until you are off supervision to be able to apply. There may be additional wait times.

ELIGIBILITY CHART

Sentence	Wait times
Prison Sentence	2 years after parole or PRCS
Probation	No wait time!
Misdemeanor jail	1 year after getting out of jail
AB 109 jail sentence with mandatory supervision	1 year after completing mandatory supervision
AB 109 straight jail sentence	2 years after release from jail

*In CA there is no true "expungement" even after a dismissal, law enforcement and some others may be able to see a dismissed conviction. If you have questions about the impact of an expungement, call Root & Rebound.
