Establish Consistent Metrics




Best Practices in Program Evaluation

Assessment In Action: SWOT

| Strengths | Weaknesses |
|---|--|
| • Characteristics of the business or program that give it an advantage over others. Assets. | Characteristics that place the business or project at a disadvantage relative to others. |

| Opportunities | Threats |
|--|---|
| Elements in the environment that the business | Elements in the environment that could cause |
| or project could exploit to its advantage. | trouble for the business or project. |



Assessment In Action: SOAR

| Strengths | Opportunities |
|---|--|
| What can we build on? | How do our stakeholders want us to grow? |

| Aspirations | Results |
|---|---|
| What do we care deeply about? | How do we know we are succeeding? |



Examples of Commitments Made

- Become more disciplined and formalize evaluation efforts at regular prescribed intervals
- Include broader set of stakeholders for feedback: More than just participants, include staff, partners, etc.
- Broaden time frame: Post hire
- Simplify and use tools to support your efforts: Texting participants and payroll tools to deploy short surveys
- Follow Through: Close the loop with those who provide feedback, take action
- Leverage Peers & Best Practices: Connect with peer orgs on how to approach areas of opportunity, share best practices
- Socialize: Sharing info about evaluation with all teams
